This is always an enjoyable evening.



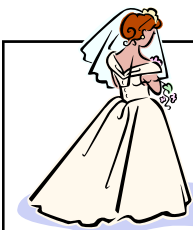
The **Summer Fete** is on **Saturday 22nd June** from 2—5 pm.
